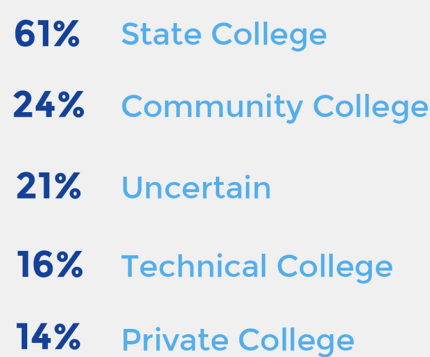


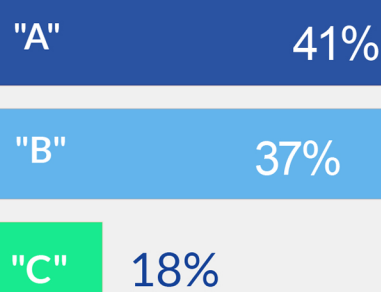

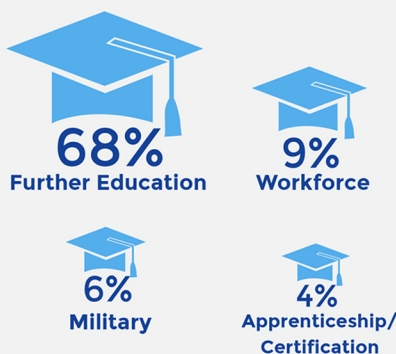

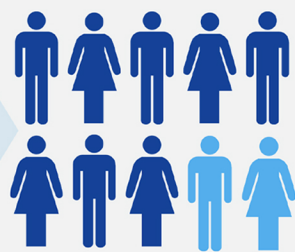

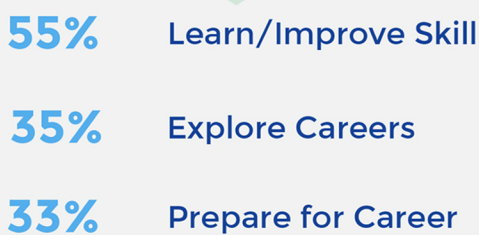

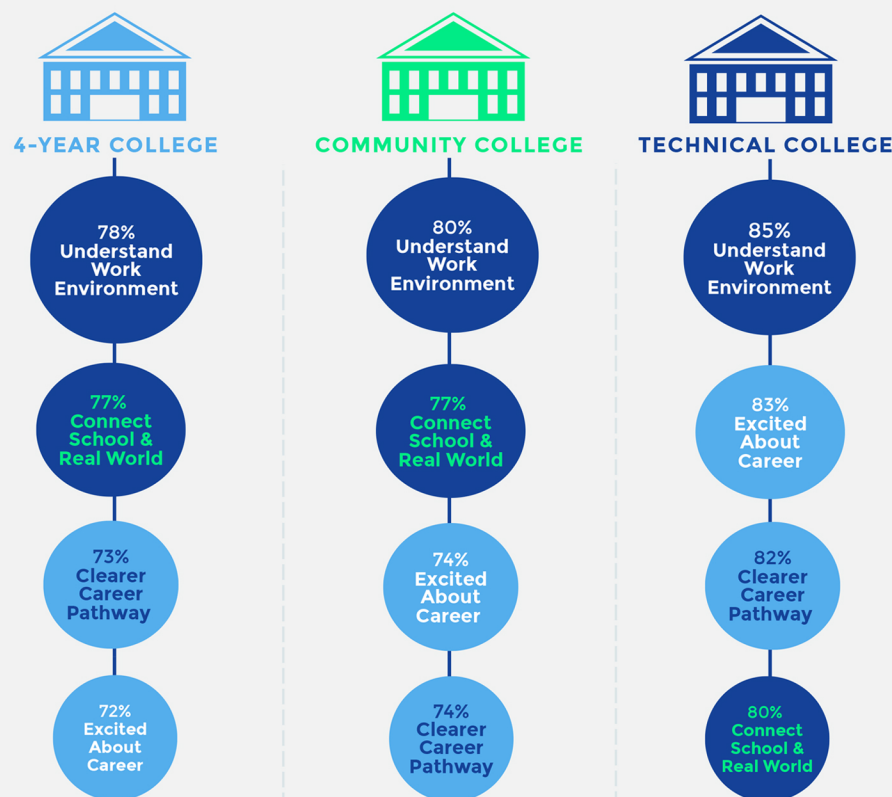

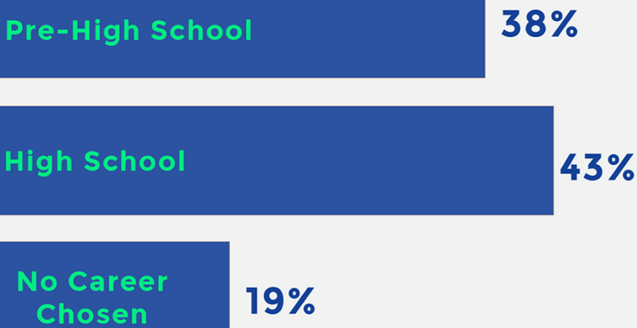
TOP 3 REASONS FOR TAKING CTE COURSES
