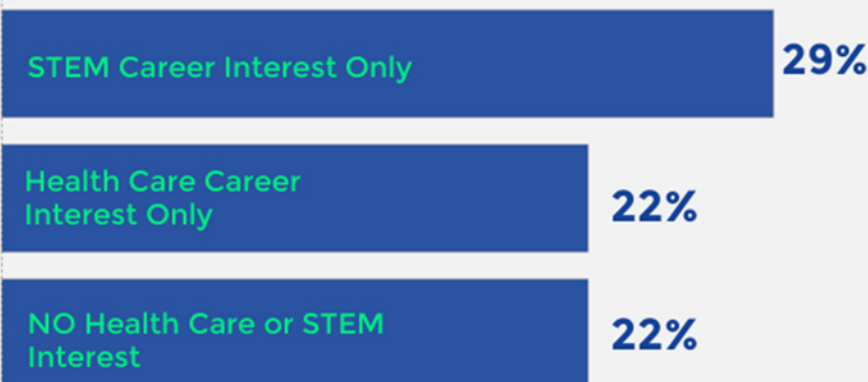

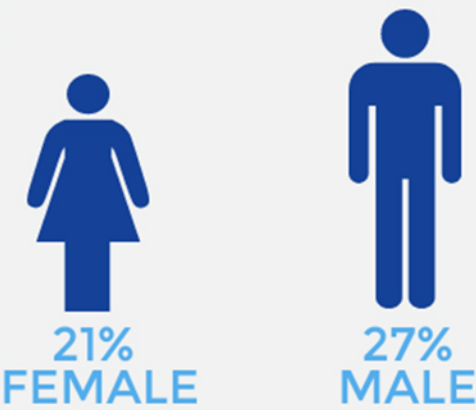
Importance at the high school level

Who Has Taken Project Management?

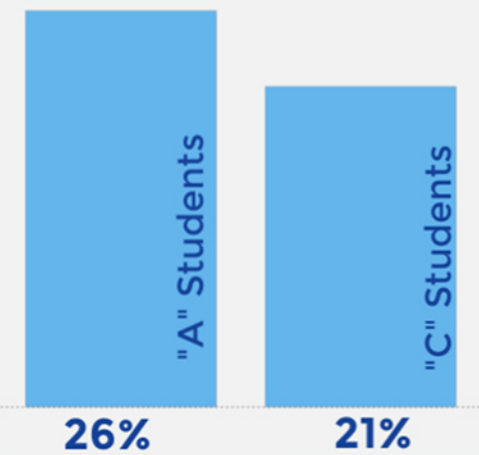
STEM Aspirants more likely than other career aspirations

Students Untrained in Project Management Think It Would Be Valuable for Their Careers Regardless of ...

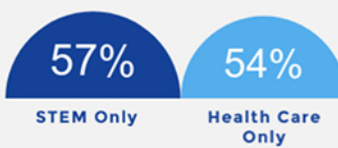

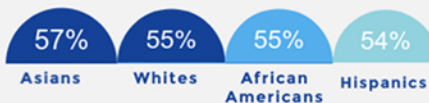

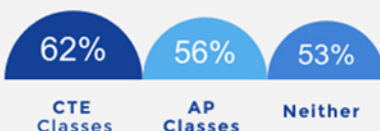
