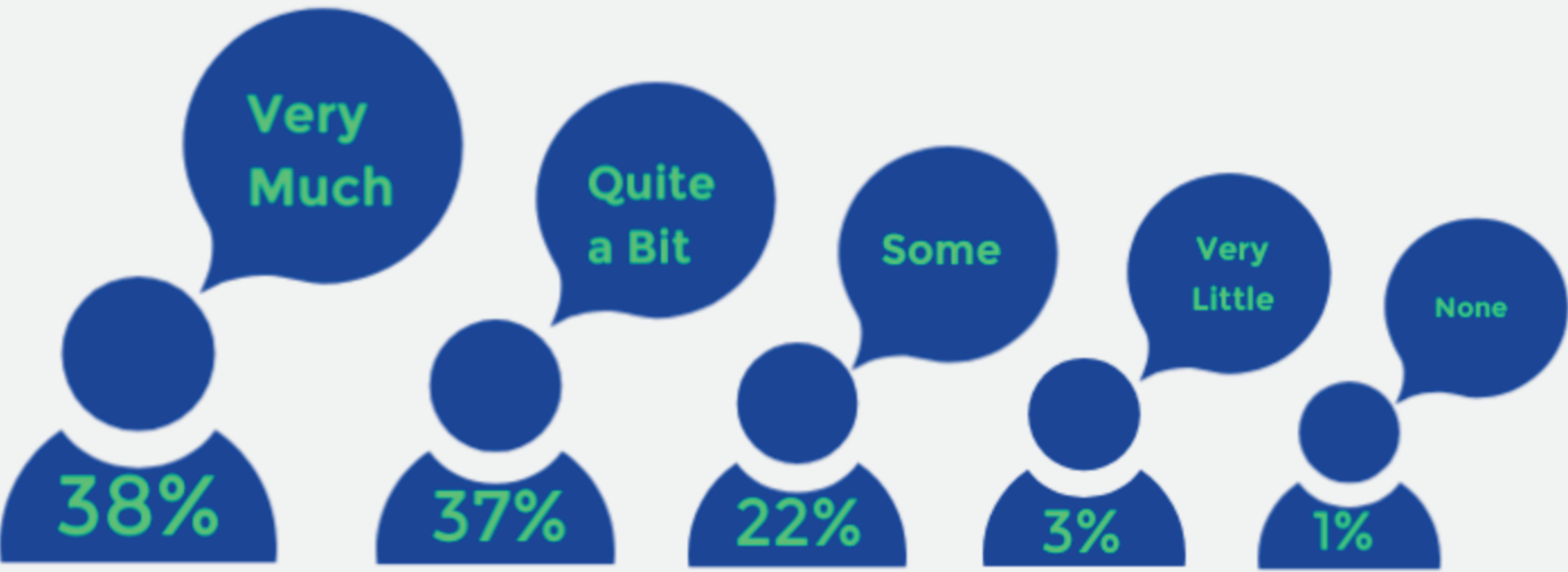

Future Careers Are on Students' Minds...



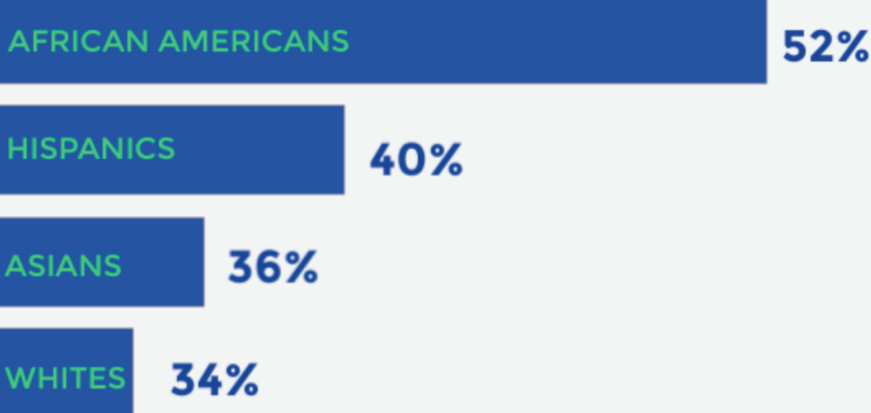
High School Students think **Very Much** about future careers as early as freshman year



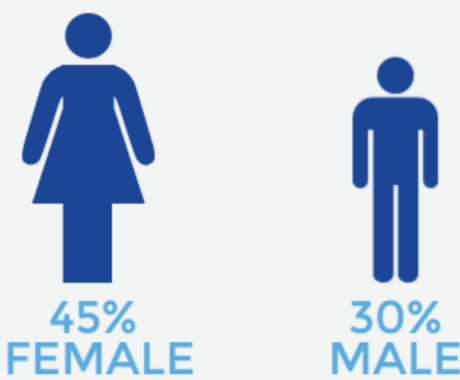
47% Seniors

Who is most likely to think **Very Much** about their future career?

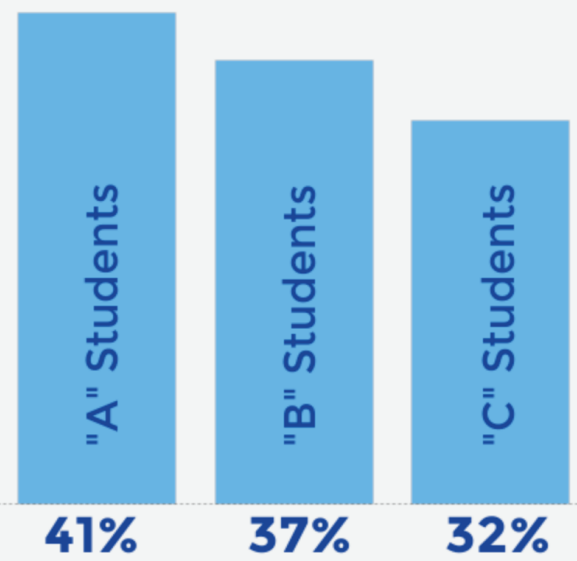
African Americans

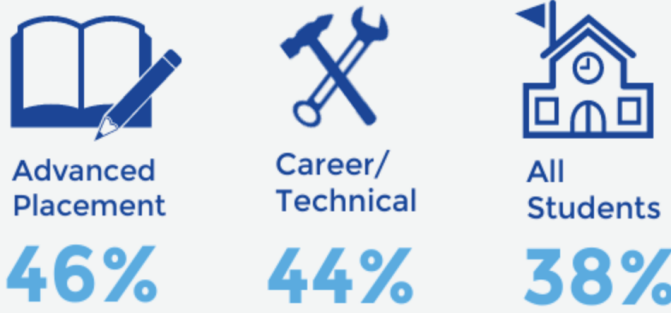

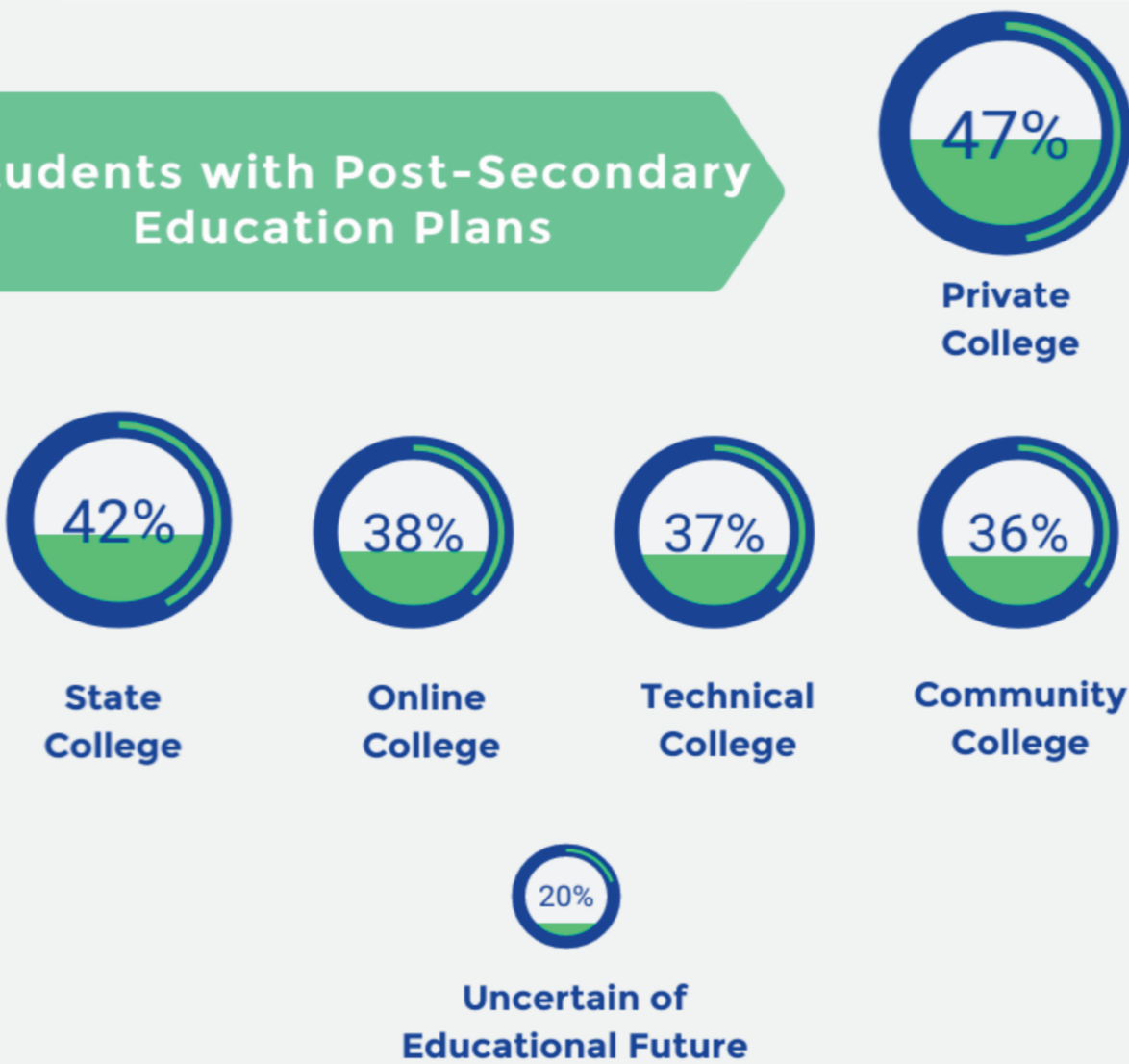
